We dedicated our Global Report on Internal Displacement to children and youth and are about to release a report on internally displaced children's education, and later this year the first report on IDPs with disabilities in partnership with many organisations.

In 2022 we did not conduct any new survey to collect new primary data on IDPs disaggregated by sex, age, disability status and other factors. We will resume in 2023. Lack of funding and human resources was the main challenge.
